Al-Rayan International School (ARIS)



Al-Rayan International School (ARIS) was established in September 2003. We are a mutually supportive and forward-thinking community. Our mission focuses on providing world class standards in education. The combination of our inclusive (rather than elitist) admissions policy with our internationally orientated curricula is an ideal framework for achieving all-round excellence. Students are supported wherever and whenever support is needed, and at the same time challenged to achieve their maximum potential. For two years we have been fully engaged in implementing and seeking authorization for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years Programme (PYP). We have also adopted the Cambridge International curricula for older students, offering an extensive range of IGCSE subjects. Most recently we have been authorized to offer the full IB Diploma Programme, completing the final two years of the students' secondary level schooling, prior to university.

The ethos of the school, and the rules by which it governs itself, are founded on respect, fairness and trustqualities which, we believe, are conducive to young people's learning, wellbeing and development. We strongly encourage our students to learn foreign languages, exposing them to different cultures and different linguistic systems, and thereby enabling an informed awareness of diversities and similarities in the global community. We currently offer Arabic, English, French, Spanish, and Hindi. Since August 2014, the Secondary School has operated from the new campus on Shiashie Road in East Legon. The spacious new campus is located in a residential area on the eastern outskirts of Accra, approximately 6.5 km from the University of Ghana. The ground floor currently houses three classrooms, a Library/Multimedia centre, a staffroom, an Infirmary and offices for the University/Guidance Counselor and the Accounts Department. On the first floor are three Science Labs, the Science supplies and equipment store, the Digital Learning Centre, an ICT Lab and two administrative offices. On the top floor are five more classrooms, an IT-equipped student workroom (intended primarily for the use of Diploma Programme students) and the Art Room. Outside the Art Room is a large balcony area.

As it is being developed, the new campus reflects indigenous Ghanaian culture, including thought-provoking examples of local artwork. Wherever possible, building designs and facilities utilise green, environmentally-friendly solutions. The human intervention, by students and staff, will have a positive, sustainable impact on our surroundings. There will be four main blocks, a separate Early Childhood Development Centre, a Counseling Centre, English as an Additional Language (AEL) and Special Educational Needs (SEN) Centres, a 'Roman Amphitheatre' (for al fresco arts events), a large Multipurpose Hall seating 500, four Science Labs, four ICT Labs, two Media and Language Labs, three Libraries, a Music Room, and two Visual Arts studios. Additional facilities will include: three canteens, a school store, a swimming pool, basketball and volleyball courts, a full gymnasium, a football pitch and a school clinic. All classrooms will have Wi-Fi connectivity and will be equipped with projectors and/or interactive smartboards, for as long as such technology is relevant and useful.

Ghana International School



Ghana International School (GIS) was founded, in September 1955, before Ghana had yet to achieve full independence and international schools were uncommon. The school's motto is "Understanding of Each Other" and its aim is to provide a world-class international education for young people in Accra in a multicultural context, for the benefit of both Ghanaians and non-Ghanaians. GIS now occupies over 10 acres in the residential area of Cantonments to the northeast of the city centre and has an enrolment of over a thousand students.

The school is a not-for-profit organization registered under Ghana law as a company limited by guarantee. Most teachers are recruited locally but come from other nations as well as from Ghana. Nations represented on the staff include UK, USA, India, France, Poland, Ukraine, Ethiopia and Nigeria. There is a teaching assistant for each Infant and Junior class. All sections use the English National Curriculum, modified to take account of the school's geographical and historical setting. Students study English, mathematics, science, history, geography, ICT, music, art and physical education. French is added in Class 2. Broadly the same range of subjects is studied in the Secondary section with Spanish as an optional subject. There are some additional choices from Form 4 upwards, where subjects such as economics, business studies, accounting, sociology, additional mathematics and further mathematics are added. Courses are validated through The University of Cambridge IGCSE examinations at age 16 and the Advanced Level examinations at age 18. The school is a centre for SAT I and II tests of the USA College Board.

GIS is a non-sectarian school and welcomes families of all faiths and creeds. There is no religious instruction or worship. Matters of morality and citizenship are addressed in the 'Values and Ethics' program throughout the school. A full range of extra-curricular activities is offered, and each Junior and Secondary student is expected to participate in at least one. The Infant and Junior schools each have an assembly hall, and share a playing field, art room, music rooms, French room, computerized library, and a computer laboratory. The Junior school also has a practical room for science. The Secondary school has a computerized library/resource centre with more than 15,000 volumes, a film room, a language laboratory, two computer laboratories, six science laboratories, playing fields, tennis and basketball courts, two art rooms and an assembly hall with a stage. The school is air-conditioned throughout.

He later had a vision to establish a school. So in 1968, Soul Clinic International School commenced at Abossey Okai in Accra in rented premises. Dr. Yeboah and his wife, who is a professional teacher with training from Ghana and the U.S., then decided that the best contribution that they could make to the city of Kumasi would be to establish a school where children could get the best possible education. They set out to start a school that would offer the same type of education that children in Europe and North America receive.

They began purchasing computers and school equipment/supplies and setting up many partnerships with schools and organizations in the US and Europe. They organized a group of American teachers to spend several weeks in Kumasi to share the latest educational research and to provide training for Ghanaian

teachers in the newest methodologies for teaching young children. The Yeboah's believe that if Africa is going to be able to compete in the future, it is imperative that the children are equipped with the skills necessary to face the challenges of tomorrow.
